

## **Prince Edward Island Report for July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

There is one modern square dance club in the province of PEI. Our club is not affiliated with a Federation.

The Charlotte Twirlers Square Dance Club is blessed to have three callers who share the calling for the club. Roger Sherren, Real Caron and Christine R-Belanger are the three callers. The three callers each have similar years experience at calling, since they basically started at the same time after the previous caller retired.

Our club consists of about four dedicated squares of dancers. We have held classes over the last 4 or 5 years, getting about 3 couples in our classes on average. We hold one major 'special' dance in the year, and some others not quite as elaborate. We have guest callers come over from the mainland once in a while and get together with one club in particular from Sackville, MB.

Our callers belong to the NB/PEI callers association and MCCA (Maritime Callers and Cuers Association) which hosts an annual dance convention that rotates between the three provinces (NS, NB, PE). The callers in the other two provinces have generously come over to our Island to give 'Plus' workshops, and help out whenever the need has come up. In the summer, we have held impromptu dances whenever we hear of a caller who is visiting the Island on vacation. Our regular dance night is on Tuesdays from mid September to mid May.
